Summary (as of Aug 2, 2012)

Stop Wasteful Federal Bonuses and Conferences Act of 2012 - Prohibits a federal agency from awarding a bonus to any employee for two years after the end of a fiscal year in which the Inspector General of the agency or the Comptroller General (GAO) makes a finding that conduct of the employee resulted in fraud, waste, abuse, or a violation of contracting requirements (adverse finding). Requires repayment of a bonus awarded in any year in which an adverse finding is made.

Prohibits an agency from sponsoring a conference that is expected to cost more than \$200,000 without the agency head's approval.
