Summary (as of Nov 22, 2011)

Cease Haitian Deportations Act - Prohibits the removal of aliens to Haiti until the President reports to Congress on the status of post-earthquake humanitarian, reconstruction, and development efforts in Haiti, including efforts to prevent the spread of cholera and treat persons infected with the disease.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 2, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration Policy and Enforcement.
- **Nov 22, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 22, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
