Summary (as of Nov 29, 2011)

Prohibits for the two-year period beginning on the enactment of this Act: (1) any federal agency from making any rule that would affect employment levels, and (2) Congress from enacting any law that would result in a tax increase on any person or entity.

- **Nov 29, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Oversight and Government Reform, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
