Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2584) making appropriations for the Department of the Interior, environment, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 25, 2011:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H5403-5408)
- **Jul 25, 2011:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 363.
- **Jul 25, 2011:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H5408)
- **Jul 25, 2011:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 363, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Bishop (UT) demanded the yeas and nays, and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption until later in the legislative day.
- **Jul 25, 2011:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H5409)
- **Jul 25, 2011:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 205 - 131 (Roll no. 630).(text: CR H5403)
- **Jul 25, 2011:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 205 - 131 (Roll no. 630). (text: CR H5403)
- **Jul 25, 2011:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jul 21, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 21, 2011:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-176, by Mr. Bishop (UT).
- **Jul 21, 2011:** All points of order against consideration of the bill are waived. The Chair of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII.
- **Jul 21, 2011:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 59.
