Summary (as of Apr 8, 2011)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Expresses Congress's disapproval of the rule adopted by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) on December 21, 2010, relating to preserving the open Internet and broadband industry practices. Prohibits such rule from having any force or effect.

- **Apr 12, 2011:** Received in the Senate. Read the first time. Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under Read the First Time.
- **Apr 8, 2011:** Mr. Walden moved to consider the joint resolution.
- **Apr 8, 2011:** QUESTION OF CONSIDERATION - Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays on the question of consideration pursuant to clause 3 of rule XVI.
- **Apr 8, 2011:** On motion to consider the joint resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 238 - 174 (Roll no. 250).
- **Apr 8, 2011:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 200. (consideration: CR H2552-2565)
