Removing Barriers to Colorectal Cancer Screening Act of 2012 - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act to waive coinsurance for colorectal cancer screening tests (thus covering 100% of their cost under Medicare part B [Supplementary Medical Insurance Benefits for the Aged and Disabled]).

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 5, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 2, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 1, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 1, 2012:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
