Makes it in order at any time through the legislative day of November 18, 2011, for the Speaker of the House of Representatives to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules for the consideration of H.J. Res. 2 (balanced budget amendment).

- **Nov 15, 2011:** The resolution authorizes the Speaker to entertain motions to suspend the rules through the legislative day of Friday, November 18, 2011, relating to H.J.Res. 2, proposing a balanced budget amendment to the Constitution of the United States. The resolution provides that debate on such a motion shall be extended to five hours. Finally, the resolution provides that the Chair may postpone further consideration of such a motion pursuant to the resolution to a time designated by the Speaker.
