Summary (as of Jan 26, 2011)

Idaho and Montana Wolf Management Act of 2011 - Prohibits any wolf (species, subspecies, or population segment of *Canis lupus*) in Idaho or Montana from being treated under any status of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, including as an endangered species, a threatened species, an essential experimental population, or a nonessential experimental population.

Provides that each state shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the management of wolves within its borders.
