Summary (as of Jan 18, 2012)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Provides that a motion to proceed with regard to a joint resolution of disapproval to the President's exercise of authority to increase the debt limit: (1) may be offered even if the joint resolution has not been reported to the House of Representatives as contemplated by federal law, and (2) shall be in order only if offered by the Majority Leader or his designee.

- **Jan 18, 2012:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 515.
- **Jan 18, 2012:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 238 - 176, 1 Present (Roll no. 2). (consideration: CR H53)
- **Jan 18, 2012:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H46)
- **Jan 18, 2012:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H46)
- **Jan 18, 2012:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jan 17, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 17, 2012:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-365, by Mr. Scott (SC).
- **Jan 17, 2012:** The resolution provides that a motion to proceed with regard to a joint resolution of disapproval specified in subsection (a)(2) of section 3101A of title 31, United States Code, may be offered even if the joint resolution has not been reported to the House as contemplated by subsection (c)(3) of such section and shall be in order only if offered by the Majority Leader or his designee.
- **Jan 17, 2012:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 105.
