Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1173) to repeal the CLASS program.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 31, 2012:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H192-199)
- **Jan 31, 2012:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 522.
- **Jan 31, 2012:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H199)
- **Jan 31, 2012:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 522, the Chair put the question on adoption of H.Res. 522 and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. McGovern demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on adoption of H.Res. 522 until a time to be announced.
- **Jan 31, 2012:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H199-200)
- **Jan 31, 2012:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 251 - 157 (Roll no. 12).(text: CR H192)

- **Jan 31, 2012:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jan 24, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 24, 2012:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-375, by Mr. Sessions.
- **Jan 24, 2012:** The resolution makes in order the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill for the purpose of amendment. The resolution makes in order only those amendments that are submitted for printing in the Congressional Record not later than the legislative day of Tuesday, January 31, 2012, or pro forma amendments for the purpose of debate. The bill shall be considered for amendment for a period not to exceed three hours.
- **Jan 24, 2012:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 106.
