Summary (as of Jun 5, 2012)

Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act Education and Outreach Campaign Repeal Act of 2012 - Amends the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to repeal the education and outreach campaign regarding preventive benefits.

Rescinds the unobligated balance of any funds made available for carrying out such campaign, as in effect on the day before the enactment of this Act.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 8, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 5, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 5, 2012:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Appropriations, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
