Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5) to improve patient access to health care services and provide improved medical care by reducing the excessive burden the liability system places on the health care delivery system.

- **Mar 21, 2012:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 591.
- **Mar 21, 2012:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 591, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Hastings (FL) demanded the yeas and nays, and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.

- **Mar 20, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 20, 2012:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-416, by Mr. Nugent.
- **Mar 20, 2012:** The resolution provides that an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 112-18 shall be considered as adopted and the bill, as amended, shall be considered as original text for the purpose of amendment. The resolution waives all points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended.
- **Mar 20, 2012:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 119.
