### Summary (as of Feb 9, 2011)

District of Columbia Voting Rights Restoration Act of 2011 - Restores the right of District of Columbia residents to participate as Maryland residents in congressional elections and presidential elections.

Repeals provisions of: (1) the District of Columbia Delegate Act that establishes the office of District of Columbia Delegate to the House of Representatives; and (2) the District of Columbia Statehood Constitution Convention Initiative of 1979 that provides for electing a Senator and Representative for the District.

## Actions Timeline

- **Apr 1, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Elections.
- **Feb 14, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution.
- **Feb 9, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 9, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on House Administration, and in addition to the Committees on Oversight and Government Reform, and the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
