NObamacare Act of 2012 - Repeals the provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, and the health care provisions of the Health Care and Education and Reconciliation Act of 2010, that were not declared unconstitutional by the Supreme Court in its decision on June 28, 2012. Restores provisions of law amended by such repealed provisions.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 26, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health, Employment, Labor, and Pensions.
- **Jul 11, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Constitution.
- **Jul 9, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 6, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee Indian and Alaska Native Affairs.
- **Jun 28, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 28, 2012:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, Education and the Workforce, the Judiciary, Natural Resources, House Administration, Appropriations, and Rules, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
