### Summary (as of Aug 1, 2012)

Ports-to-Forts Act of 2012 - Directs the Administrator of the Maritime Administration to make grants to states or port authorities to cover the direct or indirect costs for repair or construction of: (1) commercial strategic seaports; or (2) bridges, roads, rail systems, and other infrastructure near such seaports.

### Actions Timeline

- **Sep 13, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Seapower and Projection Forces.
- **Aug 2, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **Aug 1, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 1, 2012:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
