Summary (as of Sep 10, 2012)

Man in the Sea Memorial Act - Authorizes the Secretary of the Navy to permit a third party to establish and maintain, at a suitable location at the former Navy Dive School at the Washington Navy Yard (District of Columbia) a memorial to honor members of the Armed Forces who have served as divers and whose service in defense of the United States has been carried out beneath the waters of the world.

Prohibits the use of federal funds for designing, procuring, preparing, installing, or maintaining the memorial.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 5, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Sep 12, 2012:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands.
- **Sep 10, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 10, 2012:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
