Redesignates: (1) the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Hugh L. Dryden Flight Research Center in Edwards, California, as the "NASA Neil A. Armstrong Flight Research Center," and (2) the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Western Aeronautical Test Range in California as the "NASA Hugh L. Dryden Aeronautical Test Range."

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 1, 2013:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation.
- **Dec 31, 2012:** Mr. Hall moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Dec 31, 2012:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H7485-7491)
- **Dec 31, 2012:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 6612.
- **Dec 31, 2012:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Ms. Edwards objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was considered as withdrawn.
- **Dec 31, 2012:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H7512-7513)
- **Dec 31, 2012:** Passed/agreed to in House: On motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: (2/3 required): 404 - 0 (Roll no. 653). (text: CR H7485)
