Summary (as of Feb 14, 2011)

Deauthorizes appropriations to carry out the provisions of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and the health care provisions of Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010. Rescinds any unobligated balances of funds appropriated to carry out such provisions.

- **Feb 17, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee Indian and Alaska Native Affairs.

- **Feb 14, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, Education and the Workforce, the Judiciary, Natural Resources, House Administration, and Appropriations, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
