Summary (as of Feb 15, 2011)

Drug Testing Integrity Act of 2011 - Makes it unlawful to knowingly manufacture, market, sell, ship, or otherwise provide to another individual any product with the intent to assist such individual to use such product to defraud a drug test.

Treats a violation of this Act as an unfair or deceptive act or practice under the Federal Trade Commission Act.
