Mr. Hastings (FL) demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of adoption of the resolution until a time to be announced

- **Jun 28, 2012:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-558, by Mr. Webster.
- **Jun 28, 2012:** The resolution provides for consideration of both H.R. 5856 and H.R. 6020, under an open rule. The resolution provides 1 hour of general debate equally divided and controlled for both bills. The resolution provides that the bills shall be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule, with one motion to recommit with or without instructions. Additionally, the resolution provides for consideration of the conference report to accompany H.R. 4348, with 1 hour of debate and one motion to recommit, if applicable.
- **Jun 28, 2012:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 142.
