Sets forth the rule for consideration of the resolution (H.Res. 72) directing certain standing committees to inventory and review existing, pending, and proposed regulations and orders from agencies of the Federal Government, particularly with respect to their effect on jobs and economic growth.

Actions Timeline

- **Feb 10, 2011:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H613-621)
- **Feb 10, 2011:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 73.
- **Feb 10, 2011:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H.Res. 73, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question, and by voice vote, the Chair announced the yeas had prevailed. Mr. Hastings (FL) demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on the question of ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.
- **Feb 10, 2011:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H631-632)
- **Feb 10, 2011:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 240 - 180 (Roll no. 30). (consideration: CR H621, H631-632)
- **Feb 10, 2011:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 255 - 169 (Roll no. 31).(text: CR H613)
- **Feb 10, 2011:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 255 - 169 (Roll no. 31). (text: CR H613)
- **Feb 10, 2011:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Feb 8, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 8, 2011:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-7, by Mr. Sessions.
- **Feb 8, 2011:** All points of order against the resolution are waived. The resolution provides that the amendment recommended by the Committee on Rules now printed in H. Res. 72 shall be considered as adopted.
- **Feb 8, 2011:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 7.
