- **Jul 24, 2012:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - The Chair put the question on ordering the previous question on H. Res. 738, and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Hastings (FL) demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question until later in the legislative day.

- **Jul 24, 2012:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 238 - 177 (Roll no. 502). (consideration: CR H5148-5149)
- **Jul 24, 2012:** MOMENT OF SILENCE - The House observed a moment of silence in memory of the victims of the Aurora, Colorado shooting.
- **Jul 24, 2012:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 244 - 170 (Roll no. 503). (text: CR H5141)
- **Jul 24, 2012:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 244 - 170 (Roll no. 503). (text: CR H5141)
- **Jul 24, 2012:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jul 23, 2012:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 23, 2012:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 112-616, by Ms. Foxx.
- **Jul 23, 2012:** The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 4078 and H.R. 6082. H.R. 4078 is accorded 2 hours of general debate and H.R. 6082 is accorded 1 hour of general debate. For H.R. 4078, specified amendments printed in Part B of the report are in order and for H.R. 6082, specified amendments printed in Part C are in order. The resolution provides for one motion to recommit with or without instructions for each bill.
