### Summary (as of Apr 8, 2011)

Extends the deadline for the filing of tax returns for calendar year 2010 if there is a federal government shutdown beginning after April 8, 2011, and before April 19, 2011, until no earlier than the date that is 10 calendar days after the end of such shutdown.
