## Summary

(as of Feb 28, 2011)

Agricultural Export Enhancement Act of 2011 - Amends the Trade Sanctions Reform and Export Enhancement Act of 2000 to define "payment of cash in advance" as the payment by the purchaser of an agricultural commodity or product and the receipt of such payment by the seller prior to: (1) the transfer of title of such commodity or product to the purchaser, and (2) the release of control of such commodity or product to the purchaser.

Prohibits the President from restricting direct transfers from a Cuban financial institution to a U.S. financial institution executed in payment for a product authorized for sale under such Act.

## **Actions Timeline**

- **Apr 4, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on International Monetary Policy and Trade.
- **Feb 28, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 28, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committees on Foreign Affairs, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
