Summary (as of Mar 3, 2011)

Directs the United States Postal Service to issue and sell a semipostal (a postage stamp sold at a premium to help providing funding for a cause) the proceeds of which shall be allocated to the Department of Defense Peer Reviewed Medical Research Program and the National Institutes of Health for colorectal cancer research and to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for colorectal cancer control programs.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 15, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Readiness.
- **Mar 8, 2011:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 3, 2011:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 3, 2011:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
