Summary (as of Mar 8, 2011)

The Forgotten Funds Act - Rescinds all unobligated balances of the discretionary appropriations made available in FY2008 and earlier.

Requires deposit of such rescinded appropriations in the general fund of the Treasury for federal budget deficit reduction.
