Summary (as of Jan 3, 2013)

Directs the Secretary of the Army to issue a certificate of service to any Filipino national who the Secretary determines performed any military service in the Philippine Islands during World War II qualifying such person or such person's survivor to receive any military, veterans', or other benefits under U.S. laws.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 31, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jan 11, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Jan 3, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 3, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
