Summary (as of Jul 15, 2013)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Amends the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920 by consenting to certain amendments adopted by the Hawaiian legislature. (These amendments expand housing program eligibility and succession authority to individuals who are at least 25% Native Hawaiian and allow the Hawaiian Homes Commission to set interest rates on home loans based on market conditions.)

- **Jul 15, 2013:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 133.
- **May 16, 2013:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Ordered to be reported without amendment favorably.
- **Apr 16, 2013:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources Subcommittee on Water and Power. Hearings held. With printed Hearing: S.Hrg. 113-32.
- **Mar 21, 2013:** Introduced in Senate
