Summary (as of Apr 17, 2013)

Authorizes the Secretary of Agriculture (USDA), through the Forest Service, to use funds derived from conservation-related programs executed on National Forest System lands to utilize the Agriculture Conservation Experienced Services Program to provide technical services for conservation-related programs and authorities carried out by the Secretary on such lands.

Actions Timeline

- **May 3, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation, Energy, and Forestry.
- **Apr 25, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Public Lands and Environmental Regulation.
- **Apr 17, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 17, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
