Summary (as of Apr 25, 2013)

Big Oil Bailout Prevention Act of 2013 - Amends the Oil Pollution Act of 1990 to remove the limit on liability (currently, the total of all removal costs plus \$75 million) of a party responsible for an offshore facility except a deepwater port, from which oil is discharged into or upon navigable waters or adjoining shorelines.

- **Apr 25, 2013:** Referred to the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
