## Summary (as of Apr 25, 2013)

Family and Medical Leave Inclusion Act - Amends the Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 to provide for employee leave to care for a domestic partner or his or her child, parent-in-law, adult child, sibling, grandparent, grandchild, son-in-law, or daughter-in-law (as well as for a spouse, child, or parent), if such person has a serious health condition.

Amends federal civil service law to apply the same leave allowance to federal employees.

## Actions Timeline

- **Jul 8, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Workforce Protections.
- **Apr 25, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **Apr 25, 2013:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E551)
- **Apr 25, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committees on House Administration, and Oversight and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
