Summary (as of May 8, 2013)

Government Waste Isolation Pilot Plant Extension Act of 2013- Directs the Secretary of Energy to manage the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) in such a way as to include the transportation and disposal of any non-defense federally-owned transuranic waste meeting certain criteria described in the document entitled "Transuranic Waste Acceptance Criteria For The Waste Isolation Pilot Plant," published by the Department of Energy (DOE) on April 21, 2011.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 20, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Strategic Forces.
- **May 10, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and the Economy.
- **May 8, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **May 8, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
