### Summary (as of May 13, 2013)

Volunteer Veterans for Cemetery Service Act - Authorizes the Secretary of Veterans Affairs (VA) or the Secretary of the military department concerned to accept voluntary services performed by a veteran or veterans organization at a national cemetery, including the veteran's sharing with visitors of the story of the veteran's military service.

### Actions Timeline

- **Jun 20, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **May 24, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **May 13, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **May 13, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
