Summary (as of May 21, 2013)

Federal Bird-Safe Buildings Act of 2013 - Requires each public building constructed, altered, or acquired by the Administrator of General Services (GSA) to incorporate bird-safe building materials and design features. Directs the Administrator to: (1) incorporate such materials and features into existing public buildings, and (2) address the impacts of interior and exterior lighting on native bird species.

Actions Timeline

- **May 22, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings and Emergency Management.
- **May 21, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **May 21, 2013:** Referred to the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
