### Summary (as of May 23, 2013)

Defense Base Act Insurance Improvement Act of 2013 - Amends the Defense Base Act (the Act) to require satisfaction through the Government Defense Base Act self-insurance program of insurance and benefits requirements imposed on defense contractors with respect to on-job injuries.

Directs the Secretaries of Defense (DOD) and Labor to jointly: (1) develop and execute an implementation strategy for a self-insurance program for insurance required by the Act, and (2) report to Congress on such strategy and on the implementation of this Act.

## Actions Timeline

- **Aug 29, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Readiness.
- **Jul 8, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Workforce Protections.
- **May 23, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **May 23, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
