Summary (as of May 23, 2013)

Makes eligible for interment at Arlington National Cemetery (Virginia) an individual who: (1) served honorably in the U.S. Army, (2) served at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier as a Tomb Guard, and (3) was awarded the Tomb Guard Identification Badge or a certificate of participation if service occurred prior to the introduction of such Badge.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 29, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Jun 11, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **May 23, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **May 23, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
