Border Communities Economic Security and Sustainability Act of 2013 - Directs the Secretary of Homeland Security (DHS) and the Administrator of the General Services Administration (GSA) to coordinate to ensure that appropriate measures are taken to accommodate preexisting and border location-dependent businesses into the design and construction of reconfigured and new ports of entry.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 4, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security.
- **May 28, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings and Emergency Management.
- **May 24, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **May 24, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Homeland Security, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
