Summary (as of Jun 14, 2013)

Prioritizing Urgent Claims for Veterans Act - Directs the Secretary of Veterans Affairs (VA), in processing veterans claims for compensation, to provide priority over other claimants to: (1) veterans who have attained age 70, (2) veterans who are terminally ill, and (3) veterans who have life-threatening illnesses.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 1, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Jun 28, 2013:** Hearings Held by the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs Prior to Referral.
- **Jun 14, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 14, 2013:** Referred to the House Committee on Veterans' Affairs.
