### Summary (as of Jan 15, 2013)

Presidential Allowance Modernization Act - Revises provisions relating to presidential pensions to allow former Presidents an annuity of \$200,000 and an additional monetary allowance of \$200,000 per year. Reduces such pension by the amount that a President's adjusted gross income in a taxable year exceeds \$400,000.

Increases from \$20,000 to \$100,000 the annual annuity of a surviving spouse of a former President.
