Summary (as of Jul 10, 2013)

Sets forth the rule for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2642) to provide for the reform and continuation of agricultural and other programs of the Department of Agriculture through fiscal year 2018.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 11, 2013:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4376-4389, H4390-4394)
- **Jul 11, 2013:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 295.
- **Jul 11, 2013:** During the course of debate on H. Res. 295, the Chair stated that it was not in order to embellish a unanimous consent request with additional remarks in the form of debate.
- **Jul 11, 2013:** POINT OF ORDER - Mr. Hoyer raised a point of order against the ruling of the Chair regarding what constitutes embellishment of a unanimous consent request. The point of order was overruled.
- **Jul 11, 2013:** Mr. Hoyer appealed the ruling of the chair. The question was then put on sustaining the ruling of the chair.
- **Jul 11, 2013:** Mr. Sessions moved to table the motion to appeal the ruling of the chair. (consideration: CR H4383)
- **Jul 11, 2013:** On motion to table the appeal of the ruling of the chair Agreed to by recorded vote: 226 - 196 (Roll no. 347). (consideration: CR H4383-4384)
- **Jul 11, 2013:** DEBATE - The House resumed debate on H. Res. 295.
- **Jul 11, 2013:** The previous question was ordered without objection. (consideration: CR H44394)
- **Jul 11, 2013:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 223 - 195 (Roll no. 349).(text: CR H4376)
- **Jul 11, 2013:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by recorded vote: 223 - 195 (Roll no. 349). (text: CR H4376)
- **Jul 11, 2013:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Jul 10, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 10, 2013:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 113-149, by Mr. Sessions.
- **Jul 10, 2013:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 2642 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Jul 10, 2013:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 41.
