Summary (as of Nov 15, 2013)

(This measure has not been amended since it was introduced. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Keep Your Health Plan Act of 2013 - Permits a health insurance issuer that has in effect health insurance coverage in the individual market as of January 1, 2013, to continue offering such coverage for sale during 2014 outside of a health care exchange established under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. Treats such coverage as a grandfathered health plan for purposes of an individual meeting the requirement to maintain minimum essential health coverage.

- **Nov 18, 2013:** Received in the Senate.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Rule H. Res. 413 passed House.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 413. (consideration: CR H7128-7145)
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 3350 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H.R. 3350.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule. (consideration: CR H7139)
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Mr. Andrews moved to recommit with instructions to Energy and Commerce. (consideration: CR H7139-7142; text: CR H7139-7140)
- **Nov 15, 2013:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Andrews motion to recommit with instructions, pending the reservation of a point of order. The instructions contained in the motion seek to require the bill to be reported back to the House with an amendment to replace the underlying bill with an entire new text.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Point of order sustained against the motion to recommit with instructions.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Mr. Upton raised a point of order against the motion to recommit with instructions. Mr. Upton stated that the amendment was not germane to the underlying bill. Sustained by the Chair.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Mr. Andrews appealed the ruling of the chair. The question was then put on sustaining the ruling of the chair.
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Mr. Upton moved to table the motion to appeal the ruling of the chair (consideration: CR H7142)
- **Nov 15, 2013:** On motion to table the motion to appeal the ruling of the chair Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 229 - 191 (Roll no. 585).
- **Nov 15, 2013:** Mr. Andrews moved to recommit with instructions to Energy and Commerce. (consideration: CR H7142-7144; text: CR H7142-7143)
- **Nov 15, 2013:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Andrews motion to recommit with instructions, pending the reservation of a point of order. The instructions contained in the motion seek to require the bill to be reported back to the House with an amendment to give insurance companies the option to continue offering non-Affordable Care Act compliant plans through 2014 to current enrollees only, as long as those plans were in effect as of October 1, 2013. The motion also requires insurance companies to notify consumers of the differences between these extended plans and the options, credits, and subsidies available through the Affordable Care Acts exchanges, as well as instructions on how to receive them. Subsequently, the reservation of a point of order was withdrawn.
