**(This measure has not been amended since it was reported to the House on April 9, 2014. The summary of that version is repeated here.)**

Directs the Administrator of the General Services Administration (GSA), on behalf of the Archivist of the United States, to convey to the City of Anchorage, Alaska, property in such city consisting of approximately nine acres and improvements located at 400 East Fortieth Street for not less than fair market value. Makes the net proceeds from such conveyance available to the Archivist to fund repairs and restorations conducted by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA).
