Summary (as of Jan 13, 2014)

Low Income Heating Improvement Act - Amends the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Act of 1981 to revise the formula for a state's allotment percentage for low-income home energy assistance to make it the percentage the state would have received under such Act as originally enacted in the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 13, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Higher Education and Workforce Training.
- **Jan 17, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy and Power.
- **Jan 13, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 13, 2014:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
