Summary (as of Jan 23, 2013)

Savings Start With Us Act of 2013 - Reduces the annual rate of pay in 2015 for Members of Congress and the Vice President by 10% of the 2013 pay rate. Maintains the pay rate for subsequent pay periods at the 2015 rate.

Reduces the annual rate of pay of the President from \$400,000 to \$360,000.
