## Summary (as of Feb 28, 2014)

America First Act - Repeals the provision of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2013 that reduces the cost-of-living adjustment to the retirement pay of members of the Armed Forces under age 62. Offsets the cost of such repeal by reducing amounts authorized to be appropriated for foreign aid (including non-military and military assistance) for FY2015-FY2024.

## Actions Timeline

- **Jun 20, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Feb 28, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **Feb 28, 2014:** Referred to the Committee on Armed Services, and in addition to the Committees on the Budget, and Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
