Summary

Seniors' Fairness Act of 2014 - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) part C (Medicare+Choice) of the Social Security Act to direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services (HHS) to establish a Medicare Advantage Improvement Fund.

Amends the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) to terminate reduced cost-sharing for individuals enrolling in qualified health plans beginning in plan year 2015.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 13, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health, Employment, Labor, and Pensions.
- **Mar 14, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 11, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 11, 2014:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Education and the Workforce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
