Summary (as of Mar 11, 2014)

CPI-E Act of 2014 - Bases cost-of -living increases in benefits under the Civil Service Retirement System, the Federal Employees Retirement System, military retirement and survivor benefit programs, and specified veterans benefits programs on increases in the Consumer Price Index for the elderly.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 20, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Military Personnel.
- **Mar 24, 2014:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs.
- **Mar 11, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 11, 2014:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Oversight and Government Reform, and Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
