Summary (as of Jan 29, 2013)

Requires the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (MWAA) to comply with the Federal Acquisition Regulation (which governs the government's purchase of goods and services).

Applies to MWAA officials the prohibition against the appointment, hiring, or advancement of relatives to or in a civilian position in the agency in which the official is serving or over which he or she exercises jurisdiction or control.

Actions Timeline

- **Jan 30, 2013:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Aviation.
- **Jan 29, 2013:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 29, 2013:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E74-75)
- **Jan 29, 2013:** Referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
