Authorizes: (1) Nicole Hebert and Kathy Manuel, current employees in the office of Senator David Vitter, and Thomas Hebert, a former employee of that office, and any other employee of the Senator's office from whom relevant evidence may be necessary, to produce documents and provide testimony in the case of *City of Lafayette v. Bryan Benoit*, except concerning matters for which a privilege should be asserted; and (2) the Senate Legal Counsel to represent such current and former employees in connection with the case.
