- **Jan 14, 2014:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 14, 2014:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 113-327, by Mr. Cole.
- **Jan 14, 2014:** The resolution provides for a motion to concur in the Senate amendment to the title of H.R. 3547 and concur in the Senate amendment to the text of H.R. 3547 with an amendment inserting the text of Rules Committee Print 113-32 in lieu of the matter proposed to be inserted by the Senate. The motion is debatable for one hour. Upon adoption of the motion, H.Con.Res. 74 is considered as adopted.
- **Jan 14, 2014:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 80.
